Bargain Hunt

We do appreciate your ongoing support, and like to reward your loyalty with extremely preferential card renewal rates – a saving of up to £24* against the new purchase price – making it even better value for money. You can renew your card by phone, post in person, or by Direct Debit.

If you pay for your card renewal before 31 January, we will give you an extra month for free and your card will be extended for 13 months from the current expiry date.

If, however you do not renew your Card within a month of its expiry date, you will be charged at the normal prices – still extremely good value, of course, but you will have missed a bargain!

If you do not renew your card in person you can collect the card on your next visit. The computers at Visitor Reception are updated overnight and will accept your old card and acknowledge the renewal from then, however you will need to collect your new card from the Card Desk for use anywhere else. If you would like to have your card posted to you, there is a £1.50 charge to cover recorded delivery.

Direct Debits, direct to you

It can sometimes be easy to forget to renew your card on time and as a consequence you lose the loyalty bonus – so paying by Direct Debit is the easy solution. After establishing your Direct Debit your renewal will be 'hassle-free', with your new card posted to you annually. You will be notified before the payment is taken, providing you with the opportunity to cancel your card or change the structure if you wish to. To establish a Direct Debit contact the Card Desk at least a month before your next payment is due and they will give you a mandate to complete and we will take it from there.

Only You

Thank you for your tolerance of the frequent spot checks carried out through the year – whilst we found a very tiny minority of abuse on general visits, there were more frequent incidences at certain special events. **Please**

remember that your Harewood Card is valid for your own personal use only, and cannot be used by anyone not named on the Card. Accompanying adults and children must be paid for separately to those for whom the Card was purchased. To avoid embarrassment, do encourage your friends to buy their own cards...

Recommend the Harewood Card to your friends and when they buy one we will reward you with £5 to spend at Harewood. The voucher can be used against the renewal of your card so if you introduce enough friends you can have your Card for FREE.
